

**THE MONTHLY MEETING MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

SPECIAL MONTHLY MEETING HELD January 24, 2022**

The special monthly meeting of the Board of Commissioners of Fall City Metropolitan Park District (FCMPD) of King County, Washington was held on January 24, 2022 on ZOOM.

Commissioners Holbink, Watts, Harris, Wilkins and Kellogg were present.

Special Committee – Bernard Park Discussion

The Commissioners discussed the development of Bernard Park in relation to the new septic/sewer plan based on the vote from the business owners for Alternative 2.

Discussion Points:

- More walkable and accessible space; bathroom; river access; trees
- River adjustment information –What can actually be done?
- Business owners selected the cheapest option –this option leave money in the budget for improvements to the park, except for any changes to the river levy.
- Commissioners would like to see access to river long term – may be other resources to help with that in the future.
- What should the relationship/involvement with the Snoqualmie Tribe look like with park design?
- Commissioner Holbink offered to reach out to Si View as they have lots current projects associated with the river.
- Commissioner Watts feels having a connection with all the groups would be helpful as we move forward on any park design
- Commissioner Harris offered up suggested for landscape architecture – The Watershed group. He will reach out to see what they might be able to offer in terms of consultation for park design and a possible formal drawing like the one Britton Shepard Landscaping did for the county.
- Want to protect portions of the park as the septic project moves forward.
